PARTS OF SPEECH POINTS OF SPEECH

Directions: Select a sentence. Choose a block to remove. Complete the task that matches the color of the block that you want to remove with the sentence on the card. Repeat with each turn.

<u>Purple</u>: Identify a noun in the sentence.

Blue: Identify a verb in the sentence.

Green: Identify an adjective in the sentence.

Yellow: Identify an adverb in the sentence.

<u>Pink</u>: Circle the subject of the sentence.

<u>Red</u>: Underline the predicate of the sentence.

PARTS OF SPEECH POINTS OF SPEECH

Directions: Select a sentence. Choose a block to remove. Complete the task that matches the color of the block that you want to remove with the sentence on the card. Repeat with each turn.

<u>Purple</u>: Identify a noun in the sentence. Replace it with a pronoun.

Blue: Identify a verb in the sentence. Determine if the verb is an action verb, linking verb, or helping verb.

Green: Identify an adjective in the sentence.

Determine if the adjective tells which one, how many, or what kind.

<u>Yellow</u>: Identify an adverb in the sentence. Determine if the adverb tells how, how often, when, or where.

<u>Pink</u>: Determine if the sentence has a preposition. If so, write it.

Red: Determine if the sentence has a coordinating conjunction. If so, write it.

SENTENCE CARDS

You may want to print multiple copies of the cards depending on how many students are in each group and how long they are playing.

An alternative to printing multiple copies is to have the students reuse the same cards to continue playing the game once they have used them all once. The chances of them drawing the same sentence more than once or twice is slim.
