

THEME

A theme is a lesson or real-world connection that a reader gets from reading a story.

It is usually not stated by the author and must be inferred.
Themes can be inferred through character actions and dialogue, as well as plot events.

- ✓ Be prepared.
- Practice and persistence pays off.
- Mistakes are learning opportunities.
- ✓ Honesty is the best policy.
- ✓ Differences can bring us together.

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



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
