Example Answers

As you listen to *Fireboat: The Adventures of the John J. Harvey*, jot down notes about how the fireboat and its crew were heroes on 9/11.

At first, the Harvey was going to be used to ferry people to safety. When it was discovered that the firetrucks could not pump water, the Harvey was needed to put out the fire. For four days and four nights, the Harvey fought the fire. The old fireboat pumped water until the fire was under control. The crew worked tirelessly, taking turns to sleep.

As you listen to *Saved by the Boats*, jot down notes about how the boats and their crew were heroes on 9/11.

All available boats with crews helped ferry people to safety. Even though they were out in the open and at risk of attack, the captain and crews of the boats worked hard to get the people to safety. The crew of the boats also worked hard to help the people feel comfortable while onboard the boats.
