


# Merry Christmas

**Main Idea**

Irving Berlin's song "White Christmas" caused an interesting music business conflict. It was first recorded by Bing Crosby in the early 1940s. Crosby was a traditional singer, and Irving loved Crosby's version. However, when Elvis Presley recorded the song in 1957, Berlin absolutely hated it. He actually tried to get radio stations to stop playing Elvis's version.

**Context Clues**

He thrust it in front of her face while she was watching TV and waved it until she turned off the show. The bottom 25, he explained, were "optional". The first 50, however, were "required".

**Use context clues to determine the meaning of the underlined word.**

**Making Inferences**

Salvador got in the car. He turned the key, and a Christmas jingle came on the radio. With catlike reflexes, Salvador turned the channel to a news station. Ten minutes later, Salvador put ear plugs in his ears before he entered the mall. Then he spent a pleasant afternoon Christmas shopping.

**What can you infer about Salvador based on the details in the text?**

**Author's Main Point**

Holiday shopping is best done in stores and not online. Sure, the shopping crowds can be kind of crazy. However, rubbing elbows with your fellow shoppers is how you figure out what the best gifts are. Also, the decorations in the stores really put you in the holiday spirit. Finally, getting all of those home deliveries and tons of boxes isn't great for the planet.

**What is the author's main point?**

# EXAMPLE ANSWERS

**Main Idea:** The song “White Christmas” caused conflicts when different singers did their versions.

**Figurative Language:** It contains a metaphor. It means that the gift was very large.

**Context Clues:** bold, brave, daring

**Who Am I? Riddle:** Christmas lights

**Point of View:** It is 1<sup>st</sup> person point of view. The narrator is an elf at Santa’s workshop.

**Making Inferences:** Salvador dislikes Christmas music.

**Author’s Main Point:** People should do their holiday shopping in stores.
