Main Idea: People are trying new alternatives to the traditional turkey that is typically served.

Figurative Language: It contains a metaphor. It means that the children were very hungry.

Context Clues: wild, chaotic

Point of View: It is 1st person point of view. The narrator is a grocery store owner or manager.

Making Inferences: Ron does not care for Ben; they do not get along.

Author's Main Point: Sweet potatoes should be served instead of mashed potatoes at Thanksgiving dinner.
