
As usual, Clyde had left an important task undone until the last minute.








DIGITAL ACCESS & GOOGLE SLIDES DETAILS

- 1. Make sure that you're logged in under the Google Account you want to use the file with, which is most likely your school account.
- 2. Click on the links on the next page to access the files. The webpage will ask you to **make a copy**. By default, Google Drive will save your copy in your main drive, not a folder.
- 3. To assign specific slides from the Google Slides file, make a copy of your master. (You can do this by right-clicking on the file, or while the file is open, going to FILE > MAKE A COPY.)
- 4. Rename your new copy. Delete any pages you don't want to assign.
- 5. If you're using the file with Google Classroom, make sure that you make a copy for each student when assigning the file. Otherwise, all of your students will be editing the same copy.
