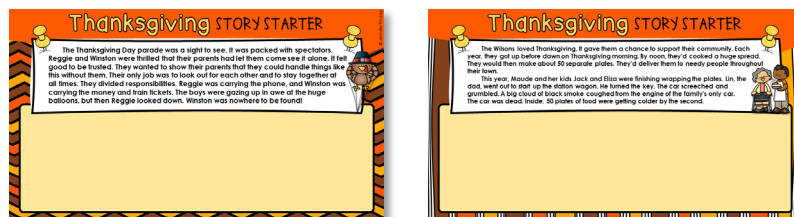
1. Make sure that you're logged in under the Google Account you want to use the file with, which is most likely your school account.
