


Analyzing the Results of a Google Form

Once your students have completed your Google Form, you can analyze the results within the form or on a Google Sheet!



When you click “Responses,” you have several options.

Option 1: View the responses in a spreadsheet format.

The Google Sheet shows the students' scores, as well as their answers to each question.



You can also see a list of frequently missed questions, which includes any questions that more than 50% of students missed.



When you click “View Options,” you can see the question, all answers, and how many students chose each answer.
